**3.3.18<u>5</u>2** Marine Terminal. A facility comprised of one or more berths, piers, wharves, loading and unloading areas, warehouses, and storage yards and used for transfer of people and/or cargo between waterborne and land transportation modes. [**307**, 20<u>21</u><del>16</del>]

**3.3.21<u>96</u> \*Pier.** A structure, usually of greater length than width and projecting from the shore into a body of water with direct access from land, that can be either open deck or provided with a superstructure.  $[307, 2021H_6]$ 

A.3.3.2196 Pier. The terms pier and wharf are used interchangeably. [307, 202116]

**3.3.**<u>302</u><del>297</del> \*Wharf.</del> A structure at the shoreline that has a platform built along and parallel to a body of water with either an open deck or a superstructure. [307, 202116]

A.3.3.302297 Wharf. The terms wharf and pier are used interchangeably. [307, 202116]
