**Errata No:** 101-18-2

The Technical Committee on Educational and Day-Care Occupancies and the Correlating Committee on Safety to Life notes the following error in the 2018 edition of NFPA 101<sup>®</sup>, *Life Safety Code*<sup>®</sup>.

1. *Add the charging statement to paragraph 14.2.2.2.4, which was inadvertently omitted, to read as follows:*

**14.2.2.2.4\* Classroom Door Locking to Prevent Unwanted Entry.** Classroom doors shall be permitted to be locked to prevent unwanted entry provided that the locking means is approved and all of the following conditions are met:

- (1) The locking means shall be capable of being engaged without opening the door.
- (2) The unlocking and unlatching...
